THE PREPARATION OF SOME SUBSTAN-
CES NOT SOLUBLE IN WATER.

BEAT these substances first in a mortar to a powder ; then, pouring on a little water, levigate it upon a hard and polished, but not calcareous, stone, that it may be made as fine as possible. Dry this powder upon blotting-paper laid on chalk, and set it in a warm, or at least dry, place, for some days.
