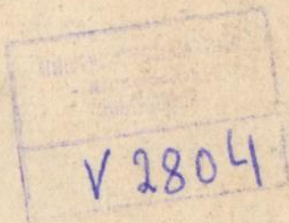

discovered in Milan in 1493.

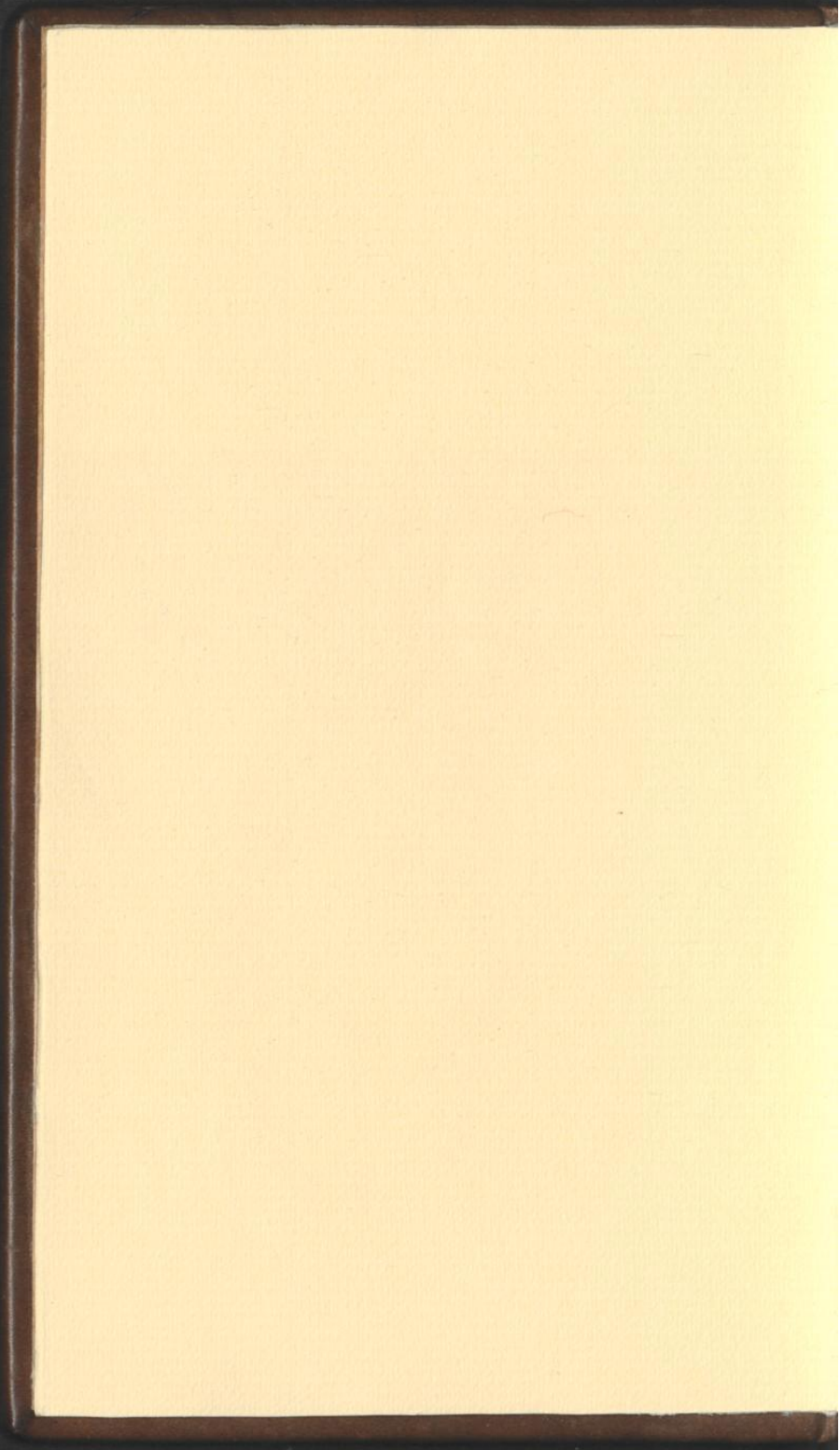

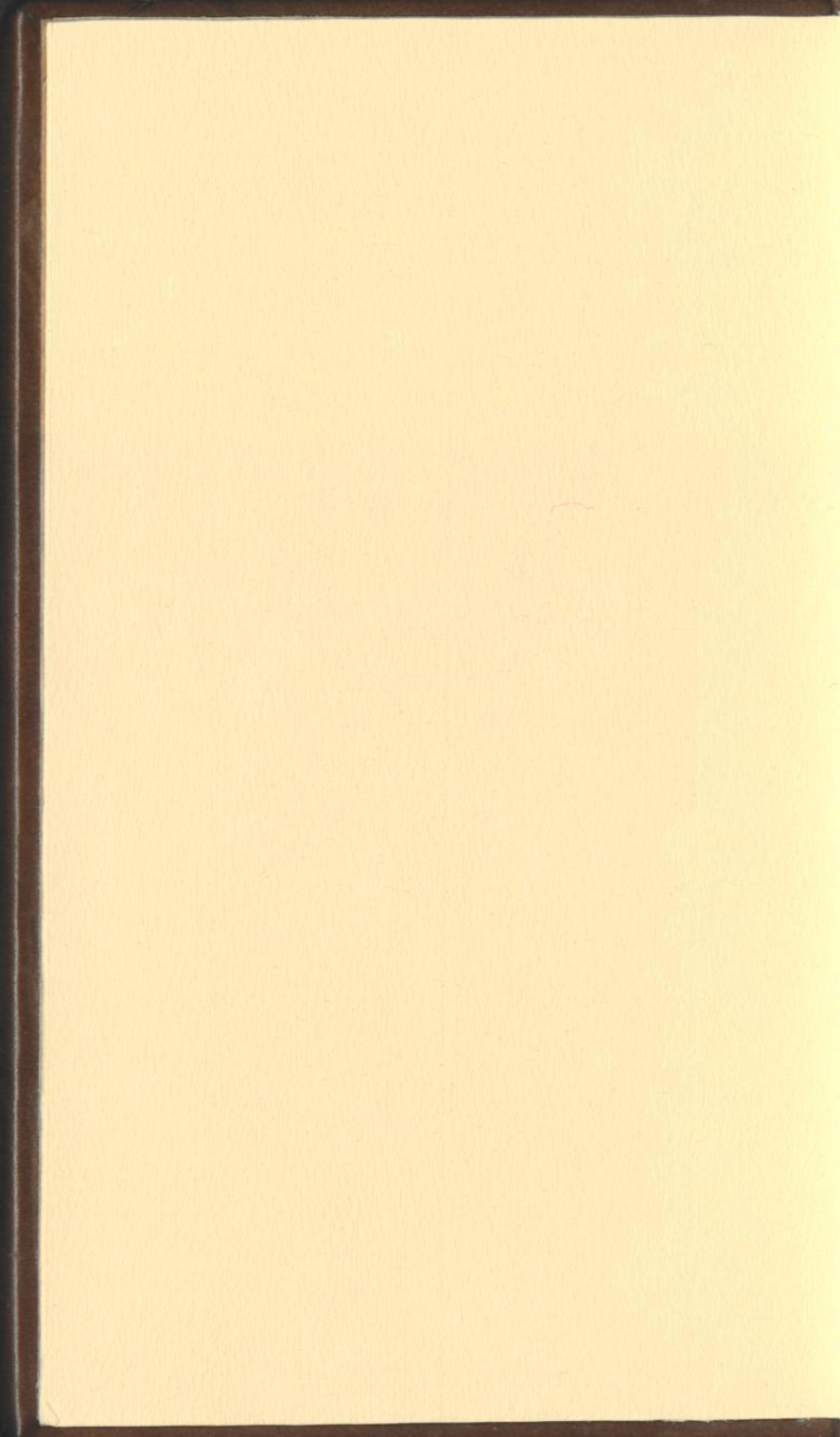

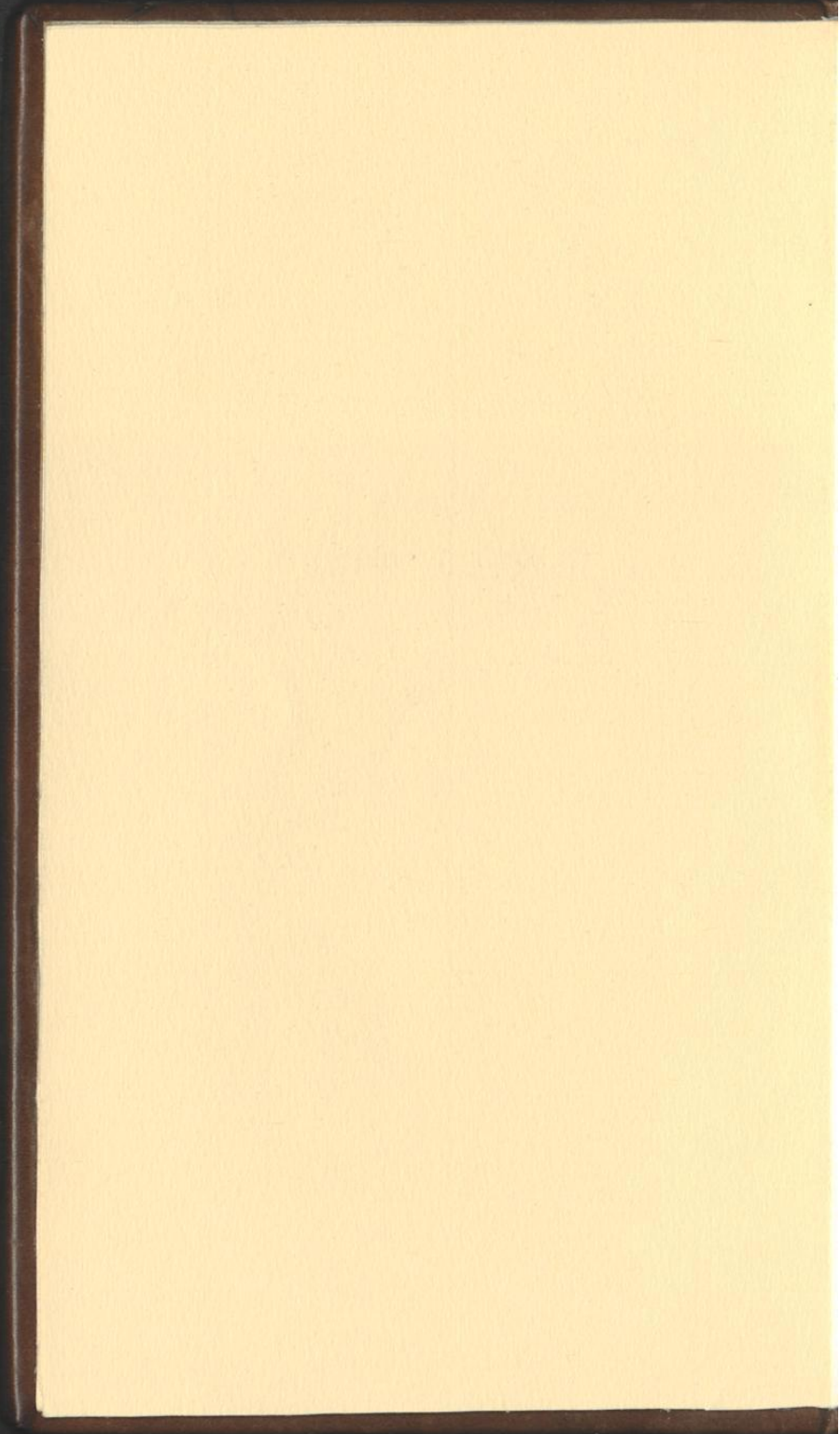
