KNIGHTS OF THE MOST ILLUSTRIOUS ORDER OF ST. PATRICK.

This Order was founded by His late Majesty King GEORGE III.; the number limited to fifteen, exclusive of the Sovereign and the Lord Lieutenant for the time being, who during the continuance of his Government is Grand Master. No extra Knights appear to have been appointed till 1821, when His MAJESTY was pleased to nominate Six, viz. H. R. H. the Duke of Cumberland, and the Earls of Ormonde, Meath, Fingal, Courtown, and Roden.


