POSTFACE.—The compilation of the genealogy ends here. Its sources are, the papers preserved in the family Bible of our ancestor; Charles Keyser—the teacher's genealogic trees, three of which remain; Peter A. Vol. of the genealogy and biographies of the Pannebecker line; Romaine Keyser's MS. volume; the Hon. Hor. Gates Jones' Levering family; and individual contributions of members of the family.

With the genealogy, also, the whole work of compilation ends; while very incomplete—*nihil conceptum est, et perfectum*—it is yet, as far as it is written, a reliable relation of the characteristics and the environment of our family line, for now over three centuries.
