## Descent of Sir HUGH COURtenay: from Evidences.

Reginald de Courtenay, came into England in the—Hawise de Abrincis.  
reign of Hen. II. Ob. 4 Ric. I, buried in the  
church of Ford abbey.

Robert de Courtenay. Ob. 26 Hen. III, buried—Mary de Redvers.  
at Ford.

John de Courtenay. Ob. 1 Edw. I. buried at—Isabel de Vere, sister of  
Ford. Hugh earl of Oxford.

Hugh de Courtenay, the first of the name of—Eleanor de Spenser.  
“Hugh,” which he doubtless received from  
his maternal uncle. Ob. 19 Edw. I, buried at  
Cowick, near Exeter.

Hugh de Courtenay, the first earl of Devon of this—Agnes St. John.  
family. Ob. 14 Edw. III, buried at Cowick.

Hugh de Courtenay, second earl of Devon,—Margaret de Bohun,  
born 12 July 1303. Ob. 2nd May 1377, buried | married 11th Aug.  
in Exeter cathedral. 1325.

Sir Hugh de Courtenay, one of the Founders  
of the Order of the Garter; born 22nd  
March 1326-7. Ob. vitā patris, buried at  
Ford before the 2nd Sept. 1349.
