Experiment	Results
1. Effect of temperature on the growth of plants	Plants grown at a temperature of 70° F. grew faster than those grown at 60° F. or 80° F.
2. Effect of light on the growth of plants	Plants grown in full light grew faster than those grown in partial light or in the dark.
3. Effect of water on the growth of plants	Plants grown with abundant water grew faster than those grown with a limited supply of water.
4. Effect of soil on the growth of plants	Plants grown in rich soil grew faster than those grown in poor soil.
